#### Horizontal. Positive versións.

The image of Atlantic Social Lab represents three lighthouses united by a beam of light. It is the metaphor of the union between points, networking, Atlantic culture, the light of ideas ... Its anagram has an extensive vocation, so it can unlimitedly expand in all directions and adopt the different chromatic variants while maintaining its essence. It is a "resilient" logo.

#### Horizontal. Negative versions.

The representation of the lighthouses, the beam of light, the waves and the horizon line causes the variants in which the light and the dark zones are exchanged to maintain their meaning intact.

The white background versions will be preferably chosen, but when the conditions prevent it, the variables can choose to play with combinations of inverse colors.












### Vertical. Negative versions.

The main scene is created on a grid of 16×6 parts. The lighthouses' disposition is vertically centered and the line of the wavy horizon, at its midpoint, coincides with the center of the anagram in its 1×1 version, which is mainly used in social network avatars.


#### Extension.

#### **Atlantic Social Lab**

The Atlantic Social Lab logo has "resilience." This means that it can be extended indefinitely to both sides, and also upwards, maintaining its identity. Its lateral continuation is guaranteed by the symmetry of the waves on both sides. The top and bottom continuation will consist of prolonging the sky or the sea that corresponds in each case.

#### Typography.

The main typography is **Montserrat Alternates**. A family of free use sans-serif fonts created by Julieta Ulanovsky. This is a variant of Montserrat, less formal in its forms.

Montserrat Alternates will be of preferential use in the title elements, reserving Montserrat for the body of the texts.

As a preferred variant, in cases where the main typography cannot be applied, Century Gothic will be chosen.

The last of the options will be **Helvetica** always maintaining the use of fonts without serif.
